#### How to verify impacts:

Option 1- Via email: When a volunteer logs an impact with your organization, you (as the admin of the page) will receive an email notification from RockServe. In this email you'll see a blue button that says, "Yes, verify impact". To approve the impact, simply click that button, and the volunteer will receive an email from RockServe informing them that their impact has been verified. If there is some inaccuracy, click "No, this is a mistake".

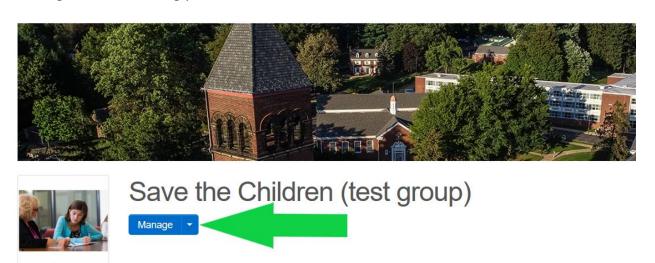

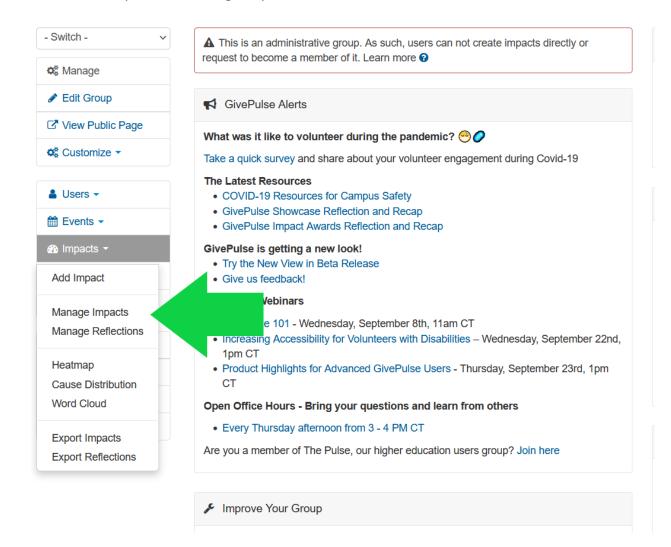

Option 2- Via your RockServe Portal: On your organization's RockServe portal, click the blue "Manage" button to bring you to the administrator view.

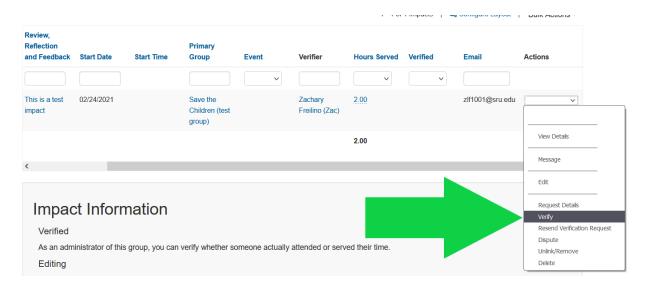


### Next, click "Impacts" > "Manage Impacts".

Once you've verified the impact, the volunteer will receive an email informing them that their impact has been verified.

#### **How to Dispute Impacts**

Step 1: Navigate to the administrator view of your page by clicking the blue "Manage" button as shown.

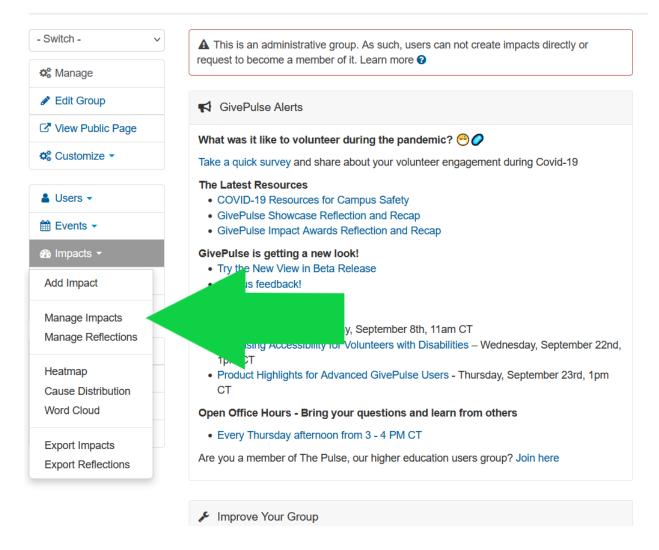




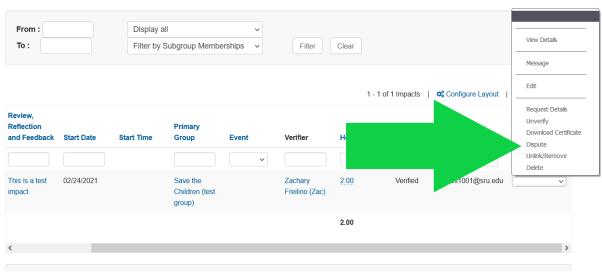

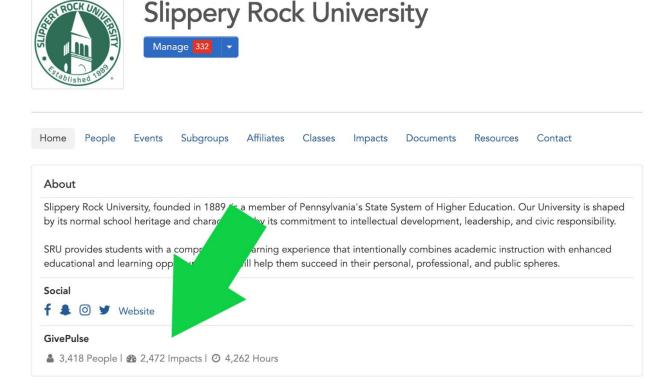
Step 4: Select the appropriate reason from the options given, then click "Submit".

To find the number of impacts that have been logged with your organization, simply navigate to your organization's RockServe page, then look below the "Social" bar on the home page.



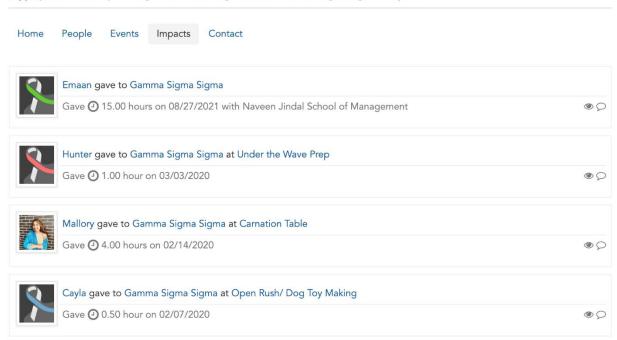
In addition, all hours and reflections logged with your organization will be visible publicly on your Impacts tab (as seen below), unless the volunteer selects otherwise when logging the impact.
